Employees and students who use District computers and networks and the information they contain, and related resources have a responsibility not to abuse those resources and to respect the right of others. The Chancellor shall establish procedures that provide guidelines to students and staff for the appropriate use of information technologies. The procedures shall include that users must respect software copyrights and licenses, respect the integrity of computer-based information resources, refrain from seeking to gain unauthorized access, respect Academic Freedom (BP 6.06), and the rights of other computer users.
