In order to contribute to the enjoyment, education and enlightenment of students and the public, it is the policy of the San Francisco Community College District to ensure art enrichment of all newly constructed buildings by appropriating and allocating a portion of the estimated cost of construction of new buildings to works of art. Such art should be appropriate both for the immediate site and for the community which will view it. Since the opportunities for younger and mid-career artists in the public art area are limited, they should be encouraged to apply.

The District's Works of Art Committee shall recommend artists to be commissioned for works of art in District construction projects through the shared governance process to the Chancellor.

The Chancellor shall recommend one of the artists nominated by the District's Works of Art Committee to the Board of Trustees for approval and appointment.
