


# To what extent are students engaging in CE coursework (based on enrollment)?


CE and non-CE enrollments: pre-pandemic vs. post-pandemic

# To what extent are students engaging in CE coursework (based on headcount)?






Notes: Headcounts are unduplicated (i.e. students are counted once toward CE if they are enrolled in any CE class). Credit and noncredit are combined.


CE and non-CE degrees and certificates awarded




### Who are our CE students (based on age)?


CE vs non-CE: Age (2023-24)



### Who are our CE students (based on gender)?


CE vs non-CE: Gender (2023-24)

### **Definitions**

### **Duplicated Count/Enrollment**

Duplicated count of students – students may be counted multiple times, once for each class they are taking. Also referred to as the "Enrollment" count.

### **Unduplicated Count/Headcount**

Unduplicated count of students: Each student is counted once, regardless of how many classes they are taking. In these slides, the unduplicated count comes from the Argos Noncredit Attendance and Course Completion Datablock, which includes registered students (excluding those enrolled in LERN, ENGL, or ESLA 1000 tutorial sections) who have at least 8 attendance hours, or a census enrollment, or receive a progress indicator (excluding 'W' and 'UG' for grades not reported) in those classes.

#### **Credit CTE Milestone**

Credit CE milestone: completion of 9 or more units of CE classes in an academic year.

#### **Noncredit CTE Milestone**

Noncredit CE milestone: completion of a CE course or accumulation of 48 or more hours of CE coursework in an academic year.



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
